



ICD-10 Code Inventory Chart

A smooth and successful conversion from ICD-9 to ICD-10 requires you to pinpoint every place where diagnosis codes are used in your practice. Overlooking even one instance could have unintended consequences for not only your revenue cycle, but also patient care.

With the October 1, 2014, ICD-10 compliance deadline fast approaching, use this chart to help uncover the areas where diagnosis (dx) codes are used in your practice, and then ensure the proper steps are taken to update them.

Clearinghouse		Contact clearinghouse vendor about updates and testing schedules to make sure they are prepared

Scheduling and Eligibility Verification		Update eligibility software & processes	
Pre-Certification/ Authorizations		Update pre-certification & authorization processes & forms	
Orders (Laboratory/ Diagnostic Tests)		Update forms & systems for lab orders/results, dx tests and other ordered procedures	
Referral System		Update referral process & forms	
Superbill		Update paper and/or electronic forms	
Coding Systems		Review entire coding & claims submission process	
		Review provider query process	
Contracts and Fee Schedules		Review all payer policies, contracts & fee schedules for commonly used codes and negotiate any necessary changes with payers	
Research and Reporting		Update all forms & processes related to clinical studies; clinical or financial analysis; public health reporting; & quality reporting (including PQRS)	
Compliance Management		Update all forms & processes used to audit or report compliance with payer & government rules & regulations
